- Manufacturer’s Supporting literature and specifications must be submitted with the proposals for each line item in the bid.
- CWWC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals, to waive formalities and technicalities, and to make an award in the best interest of the Project and CWWC.
- Factors to be considered in making the award, if awarded, will be the materials proposed, cost, delivery days form receipt of a purchase order, and references.
- Proposals will be opened in the Board Room at CWWC Main Office at the date and time indicated above, no proposal received after that time will be opened or considered. No faxed or emailed proposals will be considered, only sealed mailed or hand delivered proposals will be considered.
- Proposals and pricing shall be good for 60 days after bid opening. All pricing shall include freight and delivery to the project site or CWWC main office. Delivery location will not be determined until the PO is issued. CWWC will issue a PO within 45 days of bid opening.
- Material delivery schedule will be based on project construction schedule, current schedule is to deliver the 12 inch pipe, tracer wire, marking tape, air relief, fittings and accessories within 30 days of receipt of a PO from CWWC. Each Bidder must include on the proposal their delivery schedule which will be considered in the evaluation of the bids.
- Payment Terms are 30 Days after materials are delivered and invoices received.

Provide Materials for the Project as detailed in the specifications. The materials will consist of approximately 2,100 linear feet of 12 inch CLASS 350 Ductile Iron Pipe, 2,100 linear feet of locate wire and marking tape, 4 Fire Hydrants, valves and misc. accessories.

The water main will consist of Ductile Iron Pipe (D.I.P.) Class 350 pipe, and include isolation valves, ductile iron (DI) fittings, mechanical joint restraints, as shown on the bid sheet. THE DIP PIPE SUPPLIED MUST MEET THE AMERICAN IRON AND STEEL ACT REQUIREMENTS. In addition, to pipe related materials in the bid also includes locate wire, detection tape, air relief valve, fire hydrants, isolation valves, and fittings as detailed in the additional materials section of the bid sheet. Bidders may choose to only bid on the certain sections or line items of the bid sheet, the Owner will evaluate the best overall value and make awards based on the individual line items as well as combined bids of each separate section of the bid. ALL BID PRICING MUST INCLUDE FREIGHT/DELIVERY TO THE PROJECT IN CHATSWORTH, GEORGIA, NO ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL BE PAID FOR FREIGHT.

All materials supplied as part of this RFP must meet the requirements of the Georgia Environmental Finance Authority Supplemental General Conditions which are included as part of the proposal requirements. This requirement is non-negotiable due to grant funding associated with this project. No PO will be issued until the supplier has submitted all necessary documentation and fully satisfied the GEFA requirements. No payment will be made against the PO until the materials have been delivered and approved by the CWWC inspector.

Time Allotted: Once selected a Supplier must provide the Owner with Material Submittals within 7 calendar days. Once Submittals have been approved by the Owner, a purchase order (PO) will be issued within 45 days of bid opening. Materials delivery schedule is detailed above. The Owner reserves the right to rush or delay delivery on any or all materials in order to meet the project schedule.

Bids: Bids shall contain complete and detailed prices for construction materials for all items listed.

Withdrawal of Bids: Except as provided in O.C.G.A. Section 36-91-43, no submitted bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.
